TRANSFER IN - Esquel Airport

ASTROTOURISM | Laguna La Zeta Urban Nature Reserve.

The experience will provide a dynamic and fun approach to astronomy, enabling participants to recognize famous constellations. Through a playful and interactive experience, participants learn both from the guide and by admiring the sky itself. The region's topography favors direct contact with nature and provides an incredibly dark sky, far from the lights produced by large cities.



FUTALEUFU HYDROELECTRIC PLANTS

INCLUDES: Transfer from Esquel, insurance, and a Spanish-speaking guide. NOT INCLUDED: Entrance fee to Los Alerces National Park and lunch.

We'll leave Esquel or Trevelin toward the central park, traveling along national route No. 259 and heading toward provincial route No. 71. As we ascend the road, excellent panoramic views can be seen. Once inside the park perimeter, we'll visit Puerto Limonao, where we'll disembark to enjoy the beauty of Hostería Futalaufquen. Returning, we'll pass Villa Futalaufquen, home to the park's museum and administrative center. We'll continue toward the mural with ancient cave paintings, and after a short walk, we'll reach a natural viewpoint. The central gate stage concludes with a visit to the Irigoven waterfall. The adventure then continues to the southern entrance of the park, where we'll find the Futaleufú Hydroelectric Complex, captivating for its curious design, complex engineering, and challenging construction. Finally, we'll visit the Amutui Quimey reservoir, the General San Martin dam, the Chimenea de Equilibrio, the machinery section, the tubular bridge, and then the well section. All hikes will be of low difficulty.

LA TROCHITA

The old Patagonian Express is a true journey through time. Since 1945, this relic, supported by a track just 75 centimeters wide, has been declared a national historic monument and continues to traverse the region's countryside. The route combines the stunning landscape of the mountain range with the Patagonian steppe.











\rightarrow Fourth day

LACUSTRE SAFARI – MILLENNIAL ALERÇA (CLEONA)

INCLUDES: Guides, navigation, communication equipment, and transfers Esquel – Río Arrayanes – Esquel.

NOT INCLUDED: Entrance to Los Alerces National Park, lunch, and drinks.

The expedition will depart from Lake Menendez, crossing the Arrayanes River footbridge on a hike of approximately 2 km. In Puerto Chucao, we embark for the shore of the lake's north arm. The journey is filled with extraordinary views: of the southern wall of the Torrecillas Glacier, Isla Grande, forests, and waterfalls. Once we arrive at Puerto Sagrario, we will disembark to begin a hike that will allow us to enter the heart of the national park, which protects the ancient larch trees. The trail will take us to Lake Cisne and the rapids of its river, culminating in an encounter with the abuelo, an larch tree over 2,600 years old, 2.20 m in diameter and 57 m high, the most prominent feature of the forest. It is important to note that the trail will feature new walkways, viewpoints, and panoramic points, enhancing the visitor experience. Contrary to what one might expect, this new system reduces human impact and minimizes soil degradation. This adventure is highly recommended for those who enjoy relaxing near places of great beauty and completely free from human presence.
