wine tourism

A program to discover and experience Patagonian vineyards and wineries, learn about their production, taste a variety of wines, and, in addition, have the opportunity to enjoy the region's landscapes, history, and culture.



→ First day

TRANSFER IN - Esquel Airport to accommodation.

Dinner at a wine bar and delivery of a tasting book with spreadsheets so you can take notes during the trip.

→ Second day

Depart Esquel in the morning on Route 259, heading to Trevelin. Visit Viñas de Nant y Fall, a family-run business that has successfully produced high-quality wines, pioneering the Trevelin Valley. Tour the winery and lunch: wine tasting and lunch with a specific exercise on acidity. What is it? How to perceive it? Why is it unique and makes the wines unique? After lunch, we continue to the Nant Fatch Museum, a replica of the old flour mills from the early 20th century, when this valley produced high-quality wheat. Resume Route 259 towards the Chilean border to Sendero Lodge, located on the banks of the Rio Grande, to witness the production of artisanal sparkling wines, focusing on how acidity is the foundation that will sustain the sparkling wine over time. The tour includes snacks and tasting.



→ Third day

In the morning, we'll depart for Gualjaina, in the Chubut steppe. There'll be an introduction to the unique characteristics of the soil, climate, and water. At noon, we'll have lunch at Mirador Huancache, followed by a tour of the vineyard. A guided tasting will help you recognize the unique terroir in the wines. Next, we'll visit the Cielos de Gualjaina winery, where two concepts are explored: "living" wine, with very low intervention, and biodynamics. To answer the question, what is it like to make wine following the cycles of the moon? The tour culminates with a drive to the beautiful Piedra Parada.

→ Forth day

In the morning, we'll head to El Hoyo via Route 40 to visit the Patagonian Wines winery and enjoy winemaking experiences like the Blending Game and a mountain picnic. In the afternoon, we'll visit the Labirinto and sample Argentina's finest cider. A tasting is included in the tour.



→ Fifth day
