## Peony experience

In December, the peonies blooming in Trevelin await you. Discover these magnificent flowers, native to Asia, known for their large size and colors ranging from white to intense ruby red. You'll also discover the region's main tourist attractions, such as Los Alerces National Park and the Welsh Route.

## → Second day

### WELSH ROUTE WITH A VISIT TO THE PEONY FIELD

Includes: insurance, professional Spanish-speaking guide, entrance to Nant Fach Waterfalls, Nant Fach Mill, and Taiyo Mountain Garden.

This excursion brings together in a single tour the history, production, flavors, and landscapes that make Route 259 unique. It is the route that connects Esquel with Trevelin and the border with Chile. The first stop on the tour is Trevelin, the Mill town, the epicenter of Welsh culture in the region, with the centuries-old Bethel Chapel and the dragon in Fontana Square. We then visit Taiyo Jardín Cordillerano, a field of peonies and botanical gardens where you can enjoy the beauty of these flowers. The itinerary continues to Nant y Fall Falls, a Protected Natural Area, with three waterfalls: Larga, Mellizas, and La Petiza. We finish at the Nant Fach Mill, a replica of the old flour mills from the early 20th century, when this valley produced great wheat. Visiting the museum you can have a glimpse of the daily life of the early Welsh.

## → Third day

### LOS ALERCES NATIONAL PARK | Full Day

Includes: Transportation from Esquel, insurance, professional Spanish language guide, snack food and lunches / Not included: Entrance fee to PNLA

The tour begins in Esquel and first visits Villa Futalaufquen, the city hall and the park's interpretation center. Then we go to Puerto Limonao and take a short 500-meter hike to appreciate the beauty of La Hostería Futalaufquen, an emblematic 1950s Bustillo building. We continue to the Rock Paintings Trail and a short hike to observe the paintings and ascend to a viewpoint. Next, we head to Irigoyen Waterfall, where we take a short climb to a selfie point beneath the waterfall. From there, we enter the heart of the National Park, the Arrayanes River Footbridge. After crossing the watercourse, we follow a low-difficulty trail that takes 30 minutes and that allows you to see a young 500-year-old larch, the Menéndez River and finally arrive at Puerto Chucao and admire the Torrecillas Glacier from above.

## → Fourth day

TRANSFER OUT - Esquel Airport.
