ANNULAR SOLAR ECLIPSE IN TAIYO MOUNTAIN GARDEN

TIME: 9:30 a.m.

RETURN: 6:00 p.m.

INCLUDES: Transfer from Esquel, entrance fees, insurance, professional guide in Spanish, traditional lunch and snack.



After a delicious breakfast, your guide will pick you up from your accommodation for a full-day experience at the beautiful Taiyo Jardín Cordillerano, located in Trevelin. We have designed a unique activity centered around the most anticipated astronomical phenomenon of this time of year: the Annular Solar Eclipse. Visibility conditions for a solar eclipse are crucial, which is why we have chosen this garden. Strategically located in the heart of Patagonia, Taiyo Jardín Cordillerano offers one of the best locations for observation. You will be able to witness the spectacular "ring of fire," the visual effect produced by the annular eclipse. This phenomenon occurs when the apparent diameter of the Moon is slightly smaller than that of the Sun, blocking most of the sunlight and leaving only a bright circular rim visible. To complement this natural event, we will enjoy an authentic Argentine asado criollo (barbecue). This typical culinary celebration of our Patagonia is the perfect opportunity to relax, enjoy a peaceful atmosphere, and socialize while preparing this delicious tradition. The day ends with an afternoon snack, and afterwards, the guide will accompany you back to your accommodation.

→ Third day

WELSH ROUTE | HALF DAY

INCLUDES: Transfer from Esquel and Trevelin, insurance, professional guide in Spanish, entrance fees to Nant y Fall Waterfalls, Nant y Fall Vineyards and Flour Mill.



This excursion combines the history, production, flavors, and landscapes that make Route 259 a unique place. It's the road that connects Esquel with Trevelin and the border with Chile.



The first stop on the tour is Trevelin, the Mill Town, the epicenter of Welsh culture in the region, where you can admire Trevelin's main square. The itinerary continues to the Nant and Fall Waterfalls area, a Protected Natural Area, with three waterfalls: Cascada Larga (Long Waterfall), Mellizas (Twins), and La Petiza (The Little One), which can be explored via an easy trail accessible to people of all ages and fitness levels. Continuing along the route that connects with neighboring Chile, we will visit the Nant Fach Mill, a replica of the old flour mills from the early 20th century, when this valley produced high-quality wheat. We will visit the museum where you can see artifacts that were part of the daily lives of the first Welsh settlers. Finally, we will visit the Nant and Fall Vineyards, a family business that has successfully produced exceptional wines, pioneering the winemaking tradition in the Trevelin Valley.

IMPORTANT: Welsh Route excursions do NOT include visits to Welsh tea houses. If you wish to visit them, you can be dropped off in Trevelin at the end of the excursion. Return to your accommodation is at your own expense.

→ Fourth day

LOS ALERCES NATIONAL PARK

Schedule: Departure 9:30 AM - Return 6:00 PM.
Includes: transportation, insurance, professional guide, entrance to Los Alerces National Park, and lunch (premium picnic) and drinks.

The tour begins at 9:30 AM and departs towards Villa Futalaufquen, the administrative headquarters and superintendency of Los Alerces National Park. From there, we will head to Puerto Limonao, 4 km away, and after a short 500-meter walk, we will arrive at a must-see for lovers of fine architecture: the Hostería Futalaufquen, an emblematic building by the famous Buenos Aires architect Alejandro Gabriel Bustillo Madero from the 1940s. From there, a vehicle will await us to take us to a rock wall full of cave paintings over 2000 years old. After a short drive, we will climb to the top of a hill offering a privileged panoramic view of Lake Futalaufquen, and then continue to the Yrigoyen waterfall, located on a moderate 4 km uphill climb.



In the next stage, the heart of the park is revealed; the area of the Arrayanes River walkway is perfect for spectacular photographs. After crossing the waterway, a low-difficulty trail takes approximately 30 minutes (1.5 km) and allows visitors to admire a "young" alerce tree, estimated to be almost the age of the industrial revolution, as well as glimpse the Menéndez River and finally reach Puerto Chucao on Lake Menéndez, which, from its shore, surprises with an unobstructed view of the majestic Torreccillas Glacier.
