DAY 1

TRANSFER IN | Esquel Airport - Accommodation in Esquel

DIA 2

LOS ALERCES NATIONAL PARK | Full Day

INCLUDES: transfer from Esquel, insurance, professional guide

NOT INCLUDED: entrance to Los Alerces State Park, lunch.

Our journey begins in Esquel and heads towards Villa Futalaufquen, the gateway and interpretation center of the National Park. The route continues to Puerto Limonao, where a short walk reveals the elegance of the Hostería Futalaufquen, an emblematic work by the architect Bustillo from the 1950s. The adventure continues along the Rock Painting Trail, a dive into ancestral history that culminates in a panoramic viewpoint overlooking the deep blue of Lake Futalaufquen. After visiting the enchanting Irigoyen Waterfall, we enter the true heart of the National Park: the Arrayanes River Footbridge area. Crossing its waters, we follow a light and contemplative trail, where it is possible to see a 'young' 500-year-old alerce tree and glimpse the Menéndez River. The conclusion of this experience takes place at Puerto Chucao, on the shores of Lake Menéndez, from where the eternal grandeur of the Torrecillas Glacier can be contemplated.

DAY 3

ROTA GALESA | Half Day

INCLUDES: Transfer, insurance, professional guide,

entrance fees to Nant y Fall Waterfalls, Nant y Fall Vineyards and Flour Mill.

This tour brings together, in a single itinerary, the history, production, flavors, and landscapes that make Route 259 an unforgettable setting. The route connects Esquel to Trevelin, continuing to the border with Chile. Our first stop is Trevelin, the 'Mill City' and heart of Welsh culture in the region, where we will visit the centuries-old Bethel Chapel and its main square. The itinerary continues towards the Nant y Fall Waterfalls, a nature reserve with three stunning waterfalls, traversed by easy trails accessible to all. Finishing the journey towards Chile, we find the Nant Fach Mill, a living replica of the old wheat mills from the beginning of the 20th century. There, we will visit the museum that preserves relics of the daily life of the Welsh pioneers.



DAY 4

VALLE DE CHOLILA

INCLUDES: Transfer from Esquel, insurance, professional guide, entrance to the Leleque Museum, empanadas at Boliche and afternoon tea at Bar La Legal.

We depart from the Esquel Valley, a fascinating ecotone transition zone, heading into the vast Patagonian steppe. Skirting the Serra de Hoya, we follow the historic tracks of 'La Trochita'—the world-famous narrow-gauge railway—leading us to the Leleque Museum, 90 km from the city. The name, of Southern Tehuelche origin, refers to a native shrub and marks a site of profound historical significance: the location of the final 1888 confrontations. Inside, the museum honors the rich heritage of the Tehuelche and Mapuche peoples. To complete the experience, the museum's general store still welcomes travelers just as it did in the past, offering local crafts, books, and refreshments. The journey continues toward the Cholila Valley, where we visit the legendary cabin of outlaws Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid, ending with a delicious snack at the nostalgic 'La Legal' bar, a true treasure trove of local antiquities.



DAY 5

TRANSFER OUT | Esquel Hotel – Esquel Airport (EQS)

SERVICES INCLUDED

- Airport transfers.
- 4 nights accommodation at the chosen hotel.
- Full-day excursion to Los Alerces National Park (does not include park entrance fees or lunch).
- Excursion along the Welsh Route with entrance fees included.
- Excursion to the Cholila Valley with entrance fees and lunch included.
